Jones Memorial College Scholarship Application Deadline: May 1, 2019

Purpose

To provide monetary funds to support higher education for 2019 high school graduate members of "The Higher Way Church" Jones Memorial United Methodist. The amounts of the awards offered are as follows:

*Willie Clay Robinson Scholarship	\$1,500 one-time, non-renewable
**Nathaniel & Margaret Duty Scholarship	\$5,000 per year for up to 4 years

Eligibility

An applicant must be a member of Jones Memorial to be eligible for either Scholarship. Applicants must graduate from an accredited high school or present an acceptable GED score during the 2018-2019 school year. An applicant must present proof of enrollment into a post-secondary institution to the business office before funds are awarded to the school. The college, university or **trade school can be open to any course of study as long as it meets the standard of accreditation from applicable state and/or federal agencies.

***The Willie Clay Robinson Scholarship** will be awarded only to students attending *colleges or universities meeting generally accepted standards of accreditation from applicable state and/or federal agencies.

****The Nathaniel & Margaret Duty Scholarship** has these additional requirements to receive its award: The scholarship recipient must be of good, moral character, and must have no proven use of illegal drugs while attending college. The scholarship recipient must enroll in and, attend a university, college or trade school, maintain an average grade of at least "C" (or the equivalent thereof), and must be considered a full-time student by the university, college or trade school the scholarship recipient is attending. The scholarship amount shall be paid directly to the university, college or trade school on behalf of the scholarship recipient.

***Requirements for both Scholarships

Completed Application Form with supporting documentation

- Two letters of recommendation – from a teacher, counselor, and/or ministry leader
- Official High School Transcript or GED Certification
- Essay – Typed 250-500 words titled "God's Purpose for My Life"
- Copy of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) EFC report
- 3.5 by 2.5 headshot photo
